In recognition of the first muster of the National Guard (December 13, 1636), the second scholarship prize amount is **\$1636**.

- Current members of the Massachusetts National Guard.
- Sons, daughters, or spouses of a current member of the Massachusetts National Guard.
- Sons, daughters, or spouses of a current member of the National Guard Association of Massachusetts (NGAMA).
- Applicants must be enrolled in or accepted to attend a regionally or nationally accredited degree or technical program.

- One application is considered an application for both scholarships.

- Applicants must submit the following:
 - Scholarship Application. Please submit via Google forms [using this link](#) or via e-mail using the attached document.
 - Resume. Resume or separate list extracurricular activities: i.e. clubs, athletics, community involvement and other significant accomplishments. College students are urged to list their high school activities and awards.
 - Official high school or college transcript(s). Transcripts must indicate grade point average

- Essay. Typed and double-spaced, answer the following question:
(Requirement –3 pages, 8 ½ x 11). If references are used, cite your sources.

Leaders are expected to be adaptable so that they may be successful in dynamic situations. Describe a time you had to adapt to an unexpected change, how you approached it, and what you have learned from it that you can apply to future situations.

- Complete application packets must be received electronically no later than February, 7 2020.
